# Award Background

## Mini-McKenney

In 1974, the ACBL Board of Directors voted to recognize the masterpoint achievements of all players and established the Mini-McKenney races. Winners at each level of achievement are recognized each year by the ACBL in the April issue of the Bridge Bulletin and at the District and Unit levels. Eligibility is determined by each player's masterpoint holding at the beginning of the calendar year. Standings are updated monthly on the ACBL website. Unit 207 purchases a Mini-McKenney medallion to present to the yearly winners.

## Helen Shanbrom Ace of Clubs

To recognize achievement at the club level, the Ace of Clubs competition was created in 1984. These club champions are recognized at the Unit level and ACBL-wide. All points won at the club level are counted in this contest except for points won in STaCs. This award was renamed in 2011 in honor of Grand Life Master Helen Shanbrom of Tamarac, FL, one of the most active players in the ACBL for decades. She won the top category of the Ace of Clubs more times than any other member in ACBL history. Unit 207 provides a certificate to the winners.
