The meeting was called to order by President George Watkins at 2:40.

New Business: Laura Delfield and Gilda Reynolds presented a preview of The Longest Day, a national fundraiser for alzheimer's disease that the ACBL is sponsoring and that The Bridge Center is endorsing, and requested that the Board donate a sum of money to the event. The Board moved and approved the sum of \$500 to be used for food for the event.

Swiss team entries will be limited to 2000 points per player.
