## NAP Games

Club-level qualification continues. The strats are: C - less than 500 masterpoints and not a Life Master, B - 500 to 1999 and A - 2000+. August dates are: 9<sup>th</sup> (Weds. eve), 18<sup>th</sup> (Fri), 20<sup>th</sup> (Sun), 22<sup>nd</sup> (Tues) and 26<sup>th</sup> (Sat. day). The unit final (for those qualifying at the club-level) will be October 28<sup>th</sup> (Sat) at the Bridge Center. It will be a two-session event. For those qualifying at the unit-level (about 50% of each strat), the District 16 NAP final will be held at the Austin sectional, Jan 4 - 7 (Thurs - Sun). District-level winners (3 or 4 in each strat) advance to the national-level, played at the Spring Nationals (St. Louis).

## City Championship

Just what is the City Championship that is being held July 29<sup>th</sup>? It is a double-session, stratified, open pair event held annually in the summer by Unit 207. The event was started in 1999. The winning pair of each flight (A: 2000+, B: 500-1999, C: 0-499 NLM) has their names inscribed on a plaque and are dubbed the City Champions for that year.

Depending upon the masterpoint holdings of the pair, points will be added or subtracted from your final score (as is sometimes done in sectional team events). One half of the masterpoint awards will be based on the handicap, and one-half will be awarded normally (handicap not considered).

## Bridge Plus

Bridge Plus+ is a fun, stress-free way for new bridge players to be introduced to duplicate bridge. The game has an upper limit of 5 masterpoints. There is a 20-minute lesson followed by a short break and then about two hours of bridge, playing in a loosely duplicate format. Weekly Bridge Plus+ games are held Tuesdays at 11:30 **and** on Wednesdays at 7:00 p.m. with Mary Anne Laier. Let your beginning bridge-playing friends know about this program. (**Note: Tuesday's Bridge Plus+ games have been temporarily discontinued but will start back up on September 12<sup>th</sup>.**)
